- TENNANT, ALEX. S.**—Lieutenant, Lancashire Fusiliers. Twice mentioned in dispatches. Wounded, August 1917. Killed, 27th September 1918.
- THOMPSON, H. F.**—Killed, 1916.
- WHITE, W.**—Major,<sup>f</sup> Highland Light Infantry. Military Cross; Distinguished Service Order. Once wounded and once gassed.
- WILSON, D. K.**—Second Lieutenant, Royal Garrison Artillery. Wounded, 22nd August 1917.
