*A substantial increase in the number of journals indexed.

*The retrospective indexing of certain journals, including Craft Arts (Australia) from 1984, Design World (Australia) from 1983, DesignWeek (UK) from 1986, The Journal of Decorative and Propaganda Arts (USA) from 1986, and Blueprint (UK) from 1983. Other titles will follow.

*The inclusion of books, exhibition catalogues, theses and dissertations, and film and video material.

Daai is set up as a database and can, if required, provide subscribers with key word search facilities. Although not yet available on-line, we can respond to users' enquiries either by post, telephone or fax.
