Edited papers of the 1984 symposium held in Anchorage, Alaska, including over 100 articles grouped under section headings: general surveys; physiology and pathology of cold climates; demography, morbidity and mortality; infectious diseases; non-infectious and chronic diseases; acculturation, mental health and substance abuse; health programmes and manpower; progress in self-determination.

Another attractive reprint from Bluntisham, this time a facsimile of the journal produced by members of Shackleton's British Antarctic Expedition at Cape Royds; the humour has dated but the spirit shines through, and this reprint is a credit to the skill and dedication of its producers. Review of the question of special Sami rights to land during the 17th century in the southern part of Troms county, northern Norway. In Norwegian with 9-page summary in English.

**DUMONT D'URVILLE 1790-1842.** Guillon, J. 1986. Paris, Éditions France-empire. 355p, illustrated, soft cover. ISBN 2 7048 0472 9. 98F.

Biography (in French) of the celebrated explorer who secured the *Venus de Milo* for France, sailed the world, discovered *Terre Adélie*, Antarctica (naming it after his wife), and was killed in a railway accident after a visit to the fountains at Versailles.

Well-told, well-illustrated account of an archaeological investigation along the south-eastern coast of Banks Island, 1980-81, in search of pre-Thule sites and artifacts.
