ALAN P. MERRIAM

I very much regret to announce that Alan P. Merriam was on the plane that crashed at Warsaw Airport on Friday, March 14, 1980.

Alan Merriam came to Indiana University in 1962, soon after the founding of the African Studies Program. From that time on, he played a direct and important role in the Program's growth and development. He was always vitally concerned about its students and faculty and about its stature and intellectual direction.
