
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
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
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
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The privilege of participating in the annual meeting as a presenter, organizer, chair or discussant is restricted to paid-up members. However, representatives of other disciplines or archaeologists who are not North American residents may request a waiver of the membership requirement.

Society policy states that a person may not deliver more than one paper, though that person may, at the same meeting, chair a session or serve as junior author of a paper presented by someone else or serve as a discussant. However, no paper may have more than three authors listed, and no individual may have more than three roles (author, organizer, chair or discussant) in the meeting.

Complete symposia proposals (with abstracts of papers), abstracts of contributed papers, abstracts of research reports, and abstracts for poster sessions must reach the SAA Office no later than October 1, 1990. All proposals and abstracts must be submitted on appropriate SAA forms, which are mailed to all SAA members with the ballot.

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Because it is no longer possible to accommodate all individuals wishing to make oral presentations at the annual meeting, the Program Committee will evaluate each submission for professionalism, timeliness of receipt, substance of contribution, and redundancy with other submissions. Poster Sessions are especially encouraged and are particularly effective for presentations involving mapping, remote sensing, and various quantitative methods. The Program Committee may request that individual papers or entire symposia be converted to poster format. Symposia organizers and first authors of presentatons not in symposia will be notified of the Program Committee's decision to accept or decline the submission by January 15, 1990. Abstracts of all papers, research reports, and posters accepted for presentation will be published in a separate abstracts volume.

SYMPOSIA—A symposium consists of a group of papers on a common theme. Symposia are limited to four hours or less. The symposium topic and the individual papers within it will be reviewed. Changes, such as consolidation of two symposia or changes in the individual papers, may be recommended. Symposia organizers should contact the *Program Chair* no later than *September 1*, 1990, in order that the *Guidelines for Symposium Organizers* and a special symposium form can be sent to them. Complete symposia proposals must be submitted as a package to the SAA Office by the symposium organizer(s) and must be received by *October 1*, 1990.

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CONTRIBUTED PAPERS (20 minutes)—Contributed papers are distinguished from Research Reports in that they generalize, synthesize, or compare and are addressed to problems of theory, method, culture history, or culture process. Contributed papers must follow the same format as symposia papers, and each proposed presentation must include one (1) copy of the Submission Information Form and three (3) copies of the Short Abstract Form. Registration form and fee must be included.

RESEARCH REPORTS (10 minutes)—A research report is a presentation that describes the results of a recent field or laboratory research project. Each proposed presentation must include one (1) copy of the Submission Information Form and three (3) copies of the Short Abstract Form. Registration form and fee must be included.

POSTER SESSIONS—The poster session is especially appropriate for research results that can be described graphically better than verbally. Poster sessions will be listed in the Program and will be displayed in prominent locations. Each proposed presentation must include one (1) copy of the Submission Information Form and three (3) copies of the Short Abstract Form. Registration form and fee must be included.

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
