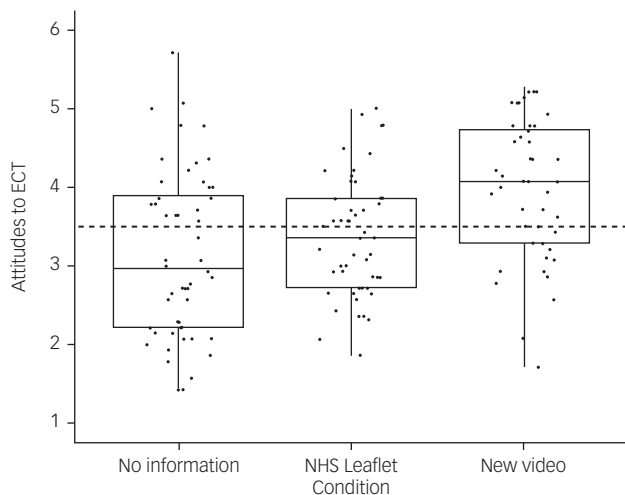


Fig. 1 Distribution of electroconvulsive therapy attitude scores across each information condition (points represent individual participant ratings).

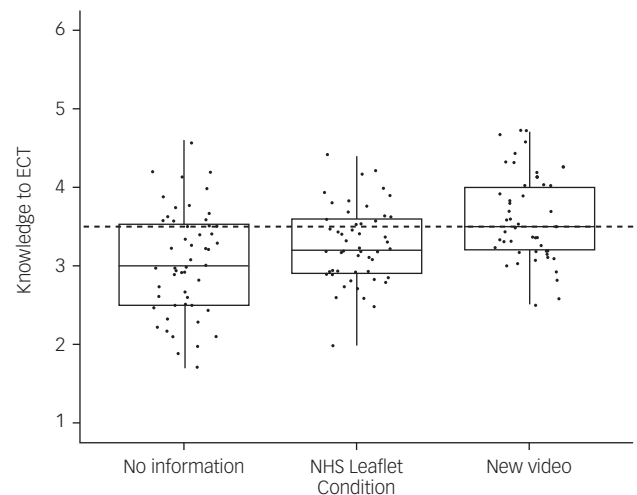


Fig. 2 Distribution of electroconvulsive therapy knowledge scores across each information condition (points represent individual participant ratings).
