THIRD BIENNIAL MEETING OF THE PHILOSOPHY OF SCIENCE ASSOCIATION

The Philosophy of Science Association will hold its third biennial meeting at the *Olds Plaza*, Lansing, Michigan October 27-29, 1972. The program will include invited symposia on selected topics as well as sessions devoted to the presentation of submitted papers.

Those wishing to submit papers should send them, together with a 100 word summary abstract, to the Chairman of the Program Committee, Dr. Kenneth F. Schaffner, Committee on Conceptual Foundations of Science, University of Chicago, Chicago, Illinois 60637, USA. Submissions of papers should be made by April 1, 1972. Papers on any subject within philosophy of science are eligible for consideration, and they may be written from any philosophical standpoint. They should be limited to a reading time of about 20 minutes (thirty-five hundred words).
