# Spirastrella regina, a replacement name for Spirastrella angulata Bertolino, Costa & Pansini, 2019 from Costa et al. (2019).

Here we correct incorrect information that was provided by Costa *et al.* (2019) on the name of the new species *Spirastrella angulata* Bertolino, Costa & Pansini, 2019.

The name *Spirastrella angulata* was already used for the species *Spirastrella angulata* (Bowerbank, 1872) which, however, is not accepted in the World Porifera Database (van Soest *et al.*, 2020); to avoid taxonomic misunderstanding we have decided to change the name of the species described by us to:

### Spirastrella regina Bertolino, Costa & Pansini 2019.

### ETYMOLOGY CORRIGENDUM

The species is named after the peculiar shape of the spiraster extremities similar to a queen's crown.
