## Investment Policy in Tobacco

Ballots regarding SHEA's investment policy in tobacco-related funds were mailed to all SHEA members with the summer newsletter. Ballots were to be returned by November 2000. SHEA membership supported the proposed motion by a

margin of 80%. The motion approved reads as follows: SHEA's investment policy will include no mutual fund that has more than 10% of its assets in companies that derive 10% of their income from the manufacture or distribution of tobacco.

## Reuse of Single-Use Devices

The FDA has just announced that all hospitals reusing single-use devices will be subjected to the same regulations as original equipment manufacturers. Some aspects of this new rule take effect within 3 months.

This is a major new initiative; for affected hospitals, the impact (in terms of policy development and compliance efforts) will be akin to the bloodborne hazards standard or the TB guidances. Key information is
