The 18th Annual California Weed Conference is scheduled to be held in San Jose, California, on January 18, 19, and 20, 1966, with headquarters at the Sainte Claire Hotel. In view of recent labor supply problems in California and other western states, mechanical trends, including new developments related to weed control by aircraft, will be major topics of discussion at this meeting. Other subjects to be included on the program will be research reports by Industry, University and Extension Service spokesmen; regulatory problems, both Federal and local; industrial weed control; and, for San Francisco Bay area nurserymen and landscape architects, a panel will cover weed control in ornamentals and ground covers.
