LONGLEY-COOK, LAURENCE H., M. A. Cambridge University, England, Vice President of the Casualty Actuarial Society, Fellow of the Institute of Actuaries, Associate of the Society of Actuaries, Fellow of the Royal Statistical Society. Up to 1949 served on the Actuarial staff of the Prudential Assurance Company in England. From 1949 Actuary to the Insurance Company of North America, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, U.S.A. Joint author (with P. F. Hooker) of the two-volume textbook on Life Contingencies published by the Institute of Actuaries. Author of a number of studies on fire insurance rate making in the U.S.A. Served in the war as a Lieutenant Commander in the British Royal Navy. Author of a book of mathematical puzzles, "Work This One Out", published by Ernest Benn, London.
