

Corrections to a paper, "Coaxial Circles and Conics," by

Page 52, par. 9, line 2.

"FPF₁P" should read "FP'f₁P."

Page 53, par. 14, line 11, insert after the word parabola

"indicated in Fig. 16 by RR₁R'R₁' which also show that the parabola is the upper limit of the ellipse or lower limit of the hyperbola"

also for the word "and" substitute "then" in same line.

Page 54, par. 16, line 8, for " $f_1S_2f_2$ " read " f_1xf_2 " and in line 9, for " f_2Sf_4 " read " $f_2S_2f_4$."

Page 55, par 19, line 3, for " f_1f_3 " read " f_1f_4 ," and in line 4, for " ca_1c_1 " read " ca_1c_1 " and in line 5, for " $xa_1Q_1C_1$ " read " xa_1Q_1c "
