

ABOUT THE AUTHORS

KLAUS EDER is doing sociological research at the Max-Planck-Institut zur Erforschung der Lebensbedingungen der wissenschaftlich-technischen Welt in Starnberg. He received his diploma in sociology from the University of Frankfurt and his doctorate in sociology from the University of Konstanz. He has done theoretical work on the social evolution of normative structures as well as research on the anthropology of law and on the social history of early modern law. He is currently engaged in a project on the development of structures of argumentation in different fields of law during the last hundred years of European legal history.

KLAUS A. ZIEGERT is a *wissenschaftlicher Referent* in the sociology of law at the Max-Planck-Institut für ausländisches und internationales Privatrecht in Hamburg. He received his doctorate in sociology and slavonic languages from the University of Münster. His publications, especially on Eastern Europe and the Scandinavian countries, include *Zur Effektivität der Rechtssoziologie—die Rekonstruktion der Gesellschaft durch Recht (Toward Effectiveness in the Sociology of Law—the Reconstruction of Society through Law)* (1975), as well as articles on the functions of law. He is currently working on an international comparison of legal systems with research projects on maintenance, bankruptcy, and hire purchase.
