This new volume of spiritual meditations by the distinguished French Dominican is permeated with the same sparkle and tang that characterised the author's *Recollection* and *Kinships*. Each thought considered emerges as a gem under the profound and beautiful treatment accorded it by Fr Sertillanges.

There are seventy-six sections in the book, each devoted to some aspect of the Interior Life—the overall title of this series of spiritual meditations of which this is the third volume. Among the topics discussed are: Integrity, Rectitude, Humility, Charity (which he felicitously calls the Spiritual Crowning-Piece), Work, Leisure, Temptation, Aids to a Better Spiritual Life, Grace, Prayer, the Eucharist, the Virgin Mother, the Saints.

Each section is short in length but reaches far into the depths of our spiritual life with a message that can do much to help us achieve the spiritual haven we are all seeking.
