This is doubly unfortunate when more books than ever before are being published. Philosophers in particular need to be informed not only of work that is strictly philosophical but also of work which is primarily theoretical in nature in such areas as law, psychology, sociology, literary criticism, physics, medicine, linguistics and classical studies. *C.P.R. / R.C.C.P.* is the first journal based in North America to aim systematically to meet that need.

Ce besoin est d'autant plus urgent qu'un nombre constamment croissant de titres apparaissent sur le marché. Les philosophes en particulier se doivent d'être informés, non seulement des ouvrages proprement philosophiques, mais également des travaux de nature théorique qui s'effectuent dans des disciplines connexes comme la psychologie, la sociologie, la linguistique, la critique littéraire, la médecine, le droit . . . *C.P.R. / R.C.C.P.* est la première revue en Amérique du Nord qui a pour propos de combler systématiquement ce besoin.


