# NOTES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

The World's Poultry Science Journal publishes reviews and articles on all aspects of poultry science. Branch news is also welcomed. The journal does not usually publish results of original research unless they constitute reports given at branch meetings.

Manuscripts: Manuscripts, in duplicate and written in English, should be sent to the Editor, World's Poultry Science Journal, 12, Ware Lane, Wyton, Huntingdon PE172BZ, ENGLAND. Contributions, which may be subject to scrutiny and editorial revision, should not be longer than the equivalent of 10–12 pages of the journal (or approximately 5000 words) including tables, illustrations and references. They should be typewritten on one side of the paper only and the typing should be double-spaced between lines with ample margins on each side of the sheet. Pages should be numbered in the upper right-hand corner and fastened together by paper clips.

Manuscripts should be headed with the title of the paper, the name and postal address of the author or authors and, where applicable, the address of the institution where the work was done.

CONTRIBUTIONS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A SUMMARY IN TRIPLICATE IN ENGLISH OF APPROXIMATELY 300 AND NOT MORE THAN 500 WORDS, TYPED ON A SEPARATE SHEET OF PAPER. Summaries will be published in English, French and German and if translations could accompany the paper it would be helpful.

Tables, line drawings and photographs: Tables and line drawings should be typed or drawn on separate sheets and their approximate location in the text indicated in pencil; they should not be enclosed by lines. Tables should be typed with adequate spacing, keeping column headings as brief as possible and they should include a self-explanatory legend. Line drawings should be drawn in Indian ink on white card, stiff tracing paper or faintly blue-lined graph paper. Photographs of line drawings may be submitted.

Black and white photographs submitted, preferably not smaller than  $4\frac{1}{4} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$  inches, should be glossy prints of good contrast and, where necessary, should carry a scale mark of magnification. Lettering should be stencilled carefully in Indian ink or preferably using a self-adhesive rub-off instant lettering. Lettering may be placed on the print or on a tracing paper overlay, which should be fixed securely to the print along one edge only.

Legends for line drawings and half-tone plates should be typed on a separate sheet. The author's name and the figure number should be written on the back of each line drawing or photograph.

Reprints: Reprints of contributed articles should be requested when the article is accepted for publication. Quotations will be forwarded by the Production Manager, Miss M. C. French, B.O.C.M.
