REPORT.

THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING WAS HELD ON TUESDAY,
7TH NOVEMBER, 1922, AT 22 PRINCES STREET, W.

Mr. OLIVER D. BELSHAM in the Chair.

The REPORT of the Council was read by the Secretary :—

The Council beg to present their Report of the Forty-eighth Session.

Papers have been read (1) by Dr. Charles W. Pearce on "English Sacred Folk Song of the West Gallery Period (circa 1695-1820)," with illustrations by a small choir; (2) by Mr. Jeffrey Pulver on "The Music of Ancient Egypt"; (3) by Mr. Eugene Goossens, junr., on "Modern Developments in Music"; (4) by Mr. E. Lancaster Jones on "Sound-ranging: with special reference to its use during the recent War," a number of models, &c., being exhibited; (5) by Mr. F. Gilbert Webb on "The Emanuel Moor Duplex Coupler Piano," with illustrations by Miss Winifred Christie; and (6) by Dr. Cyril B. Rootham, on "Music in the Universities," making use of the notes put together by Sir Hugh Allen, who was unfortunately prevented by illness from completing the paper himself. The Council desire to record here their sincerest thanks to the above-mentioned ladies and gentlemen for their valued contributions to the Proceedings of the Association.

The attendance at the Meetings has been fairly well maintained, though the Council would be glad to see an improvement in this respect. It would promote interest in the Association and induce better discussions. Again it may be pointed out that the half hour during which afternoon tea is provided prior to the reading of the paper, affords a useful opportunity for members to meet one another.

During the past session thirty-two new members have been elected, the numbers on the books at 30 June, 1922, being 234 of all classes. In the course of the last four years 106 new members have been added to the Association, a very

satisfactory increase, which has enabled the financial equilibrium to be re-established after the disturbing influences of war-time; at the same time, it must not be overlooked that death, resignation and other causes have to be set against this increase. The Council earnestly trust that efforts to gain new members will not be relaxed, in order that by the time the 50th year of the Association arrives in 1924, the membership will have reached a total of at least 300.

The Council have to record with deep regret the loss by death of Sir Edward E. Cooper, Bart., Mr. W. D. St. Leger, Mr. Arthur Hervey, Mr. H. Granville Sharp and Mr. William Welch.

The Financial Statement to be submitted discloses a gratifying improvement, and there is a substantial balance in hand.

The thanks of the Association are cordially offered to Messrs. Novello & Co., for accommodation for the Meetings, held at their premises during the past Session and to their staff for courteous assistance in connection therewith.

Owing to certain practical considerations, the Council have decided to accept an offer made some time back by Dr. Yorke Trotter, and to hold the meetings at the London Academy of Music, 22 Princes Street, Cavendish Square. They desire to express the most cordial appreciation of the generous hospitality of Messrs. Novello & Co., during the last nine years, a hospitality which was of material assistance to the Association in the difficult situation caused by the War, and to offer them their warmest thanks for their kindness.

In accordance with Articles of Association, the President, Vice-Presidents, and the following five Ordinary Members of Council retire from office; Mr. W. W. Cobbett, Mr. Harvey Grace, Mr. H.
