## The community response

This study is based on research into the ways practitioners in the medical, legal, and social services view marriage and violence, and examines marital violence from a number of perspectives. The authors investigate the ways in which different agencies and practitioners respond to the problem of marital violence. They use a combination of statistical evidence and interviews with practitioners and victims themselves to build up a picture of the extent of the problem and the ways in which the attitudes and the professional status of the practitioners form a response that is in varying degrees adequate or otherwise to deal with the problems that exist.

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
