## New Course on English Phonetics

JWL writes: Many teachers in universities and similar institutions throughout the world are required to specialize in the teaching of spoken English. Yet there has apparently never been a full-time one-year course at any British university specifically dedicated to training such specialists or providing them with a refresher course covering more recent developments in the subject. From October 1984 the omission will be repaired by the Department of Linguistics and Phonetics at Leeds who will be offering a new Postgraduate Diploma in the Phonetics of English specially designed for teachers of those for whom English is not their mother tongue. It will, in the well-known British tradition, have a substantial practical component. Part of the course will be devoted to an area of special interest to the participant within the range of the subject.
