

EDITORIAL NOTE

We like to draw your attention to the following:

- Starting with Volume 10, Mathematical Reviews abstracts our journal. This is clearly a recognition of our present editorial standards and of non-life insurance as an important field of applications.
- In 1980, an index of the first 10 volumes will be published. This index will be on authors and subjects.
- Starting with Volume 11, publication of Astin Bulletin will follow a regular pattern. Each volume will consist of two parts of approximately 80 pages. Publication will be in June and December.
- The editorial processing may be considered to be on schedule now. We hope to keep it that way. Authors can help us in this matter if they submit their papers also in between Astin Colloquia. This will decline the peaked supply of papers just after a colloquium. Authors may expect to receive a first decision as regards their paper within 3 months after submission, cases exceeding this term being outliers.
