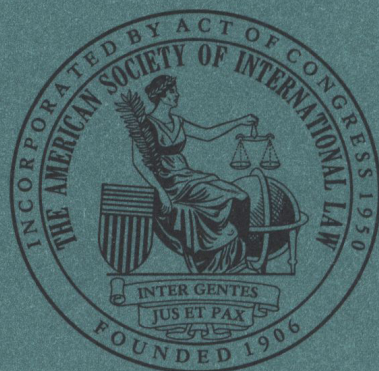

PATRONAGE, GIFTS AND BEQUESTS
