

## **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

### **National Council on Soviet and East European Research**

NCSEER invites proposals for its program of funding for research and related activities dealing with the social, political, economic, and historical development of the USSR and Eastern Europe.

Applications must be submitted through U.S. non-profit and educational institutions and should take the form of an institutional proposal for a research contract. Eligibility for Principal Investigators is limited to scholars at the post-doctoral level for academic participants, and to an equivalent degree of maturity and professional achievement for those from other fields. Projects should be limited in duration to not more than one academic year and two summers. The Council will not normally make awards of more than \$50,000 for any individual project. The Council operates with public funds and, assuming an award, its program will be funded exclusively by the Department of State under Title VIII legislation.
