THE JOURNALS OF THE SOCIETY

The Society publishes two Journals annually. The *Journal of Roman Studies* contains articles and reviews of books and deals with the Roman World at large. *Britannia* also contains articles and reviews, but is specifically concerned with Roman Britain. Members of the Society may receive either Journal, whichever they choose, for their £12.00 subscription; they are also entitled to subscribe to both publications at a reduced rate of £20.50. Subscribing libraries pay £13.00 for each publication and non-subscribers £18.00.

THE LIBRARY AND SLIDE COLLECTION

The Hellenic and Roman Societies maintain a Joint Library in association with the University of London Institute of Classical Studies. The combined library of c. 50,000 volumes, with nearly 400 current periodicals, forms one of the principal collections for the study of the ancient world. The Slide Collection includes over 4,600 single colour transparencies and a number of sets and film-strips with descriptive texts by leading authorities. Members resident in, or visiting, the United Kingdom may borrow the Societies' books and slides, either by personal visit or through the post. Books which belong to the Institute of Classical Studies may be consulted but not borrowed.

MEETINGS

Meetings for the reading and discussion of papers are held at Gordon Square and others are arranged at various places in the country. A programme is circulated to U.K. members in the autumn.
