## The Trial of Oliver Plunkett

On July 1, 1681, Oliver Plunkett, Catholic Archbishop of Armagh was hanged, drawn and quartered—the last person to be executed in connection with "The Popish Plot". Alice Curtayne conducts us through the story—the trial as taken down by the court reporters, with the background filled in at every point: the political intrigues in London, with Lord Shaftesbury goading the mob to cry "Treason" against the Archbishop while plotting treason himself, the story of each witness, the degradations and the heroisms of oppressed Ireland, conditions in Newgate, the relations between England, France and Spain, the earlier Popish Plot trials; and through it all the simplicity and holiness of Plunkett himself.

The book has a particular contemporary interest, as the author points out in her Foreword, because of the similarity between Plunkett's trial and that of Cardinal Mindszenty in 1949.
